Detached Indians living either in white or negro families outside of reservations should be enumerated on the general population schedule (Form 7-844) and the number of the families in which they are found; but detached whites or negroes living in Indian families should be enumerated on this schedule as members of the Indian families in which they are found. In other words, every family composed mainly of Indians should be reported entirely on this schedule, and every family composed mainly of persons not Indians should be reported entirely on the general population schedule.

This schedule contains on each side twenty horizontal lines, each running twice across the page, and it is consequently possible to enumerate on it only forty persons (twenty persons on the A side and twenty persons on the B side). Each Indian should be carried from the A side to the B side at the end of the line on which he is entered, as line 1, line 2, etc., and each inquiry from column 1 to column 30 which applies to the individual case should be made.

Columns 1 to 30.—These columns are identical with those on the general population schedule. Fill each column, so far as the inquiry applies, in accordance with the instructions for filling the corresponding columns in the general population schedule, but note the following additional instructions in relation to filling columns 1, 2, and 30:

Column 1 AND 2.—If you are enumerating a given territory with both the general population schedule (Form 7-844) and this schedule for Indians, make two independent counts of Indians to be entered on the two schedules series in the kind of entries, as follows: On the A side enter the total number of Indians in the territory, and on the B side enter the total number of Indians in the territory, and add the two totals to give the whole number of dwellings and of families visited and enumerated in your tribal district.

Column 18.—If the Indian has no residence and is wholly dependent on the Government for support, write "Bureau Indian." If fully dependent on the Government and partly dependent upon the Government, write "B" and "G" before the letter "B" (for nation). If the Indian is partly self-supporting and receives rations, write "Under agent."

Detached Indians living either in white or negro families outside of reservations should be enumerated on the general population schedule (Form 7-224) as members of the families in which they are found; but detached white or negro living in Indian families should be enumerated on this schedule as members of the Indian families in which they are found. In other words, every family composed mainly of Indians should be reported entirely on this schedule, and every family composed mainly of Indians and not Indian should be reported entirely on the general population schedule.

This schedule contains on each side two horizontal lines, each running twice across the page, and it is necessary to indicate on it only one name (name of the Indian) on the A side and twenty persons on the B side. Each Indian should be carried through from the beginning to the end of the line on which he is entered, as line 1, line 2, etc., and each inquiry from column 1 to column 30 which applies to the individual case should be answered.

Columns 1 and 2.—These columns are identical with those on the general population schedule. Fill each column, so far as the inquiry applies, in accordance with the instructions for filling the corresponding columns in the general population schedule, but note the following additional instructions in relation to filling columns 1, 2, and 19:

Column 1.—If the Indian has no companion and is wholly dependent on the Government for support, write "Nation Indian." If he is partly self-supporting and partly dependent upon the Government, write the companion's name and then the letter "B" (see notes). If the Indian is under ten years of age and receives wages, write "Under aged."

COLUMN 30, 31, AND 32.—If the Indian was born in this country answers should be obtained, if possible, to inquiries 13, 14, and 15, relating to the name of the tribe with which the person is connected and the name of his or her parents, and enter the same in columns 30, 31, and 32.

COLUMN 33.—If the Indian has no white blood, write 0. If he or she has white blood, write 1, 2, 3, whichever fraction is nearest the truth.

COLUMN 34.—If the Indian man is living with more than one wife, or if the Indian woman is living with more than one husband, write "Yes." If not, write "No." If the Indian is single, leave the column blank.

COLUMN 35.—If the Indian was born in this country, no entry can be made in columns 16, 17, and 18; but for columns 24, 25, and 27, an entry must be made in both columns 16, 17, and 18, and in columns 24, 25, and 27, in accordance with the facts.

An Indian on a reservation, without allotment, or residing over unsettled territory, is considered "not taxed," and for such Indians the answer to this question is "No."

COLUMN 36.—If the Indian was born in tribal relations, and has acquired American citizenship, write the year in which it was acquired. If he or she has not acquired citizenship, leave the column blank.

COLUMN 37.—If the Indian acquired citizenship by receiving an allotment from the Government, write "Yes." If he or she acquired citizenship by other means, write "No." If he or she has not acquired American citizenship, leave the column blank.

COLUMN 38.—If the Indian is living in a tent, traps, or other temporary structure, write "unsheltered." If he or she is living in a permanent dwelling of any kind, write "sheltered."

In other words, every family composed mainly of Indians should be reported on this schedule, and every family composed mainly of persons not Indians should be reported entirely on the general population schedule.

This schedule contains on each side twenty horizontal lines, each running twice across the page, and it is consequently possible to enumerate on it only twenty persons on the A side and twenty persons on the B side. Each Indian should be carried through from the beginning to the end of the line on which he is entered, as lines 1, line 2, etc., and each Indian from column 1 to column 35 which applies to his individual case should be answered.

COLUMNS 1 TO 35.—These columns are identical with those on the general population schedule. Fill each column so far as the inquiry applies, in accordance with the instructions given below, corresponding columns in the general population schedule, but note the following additional instructions in regard to filling columns 1, 2, and 3:

Column 1.—If Indians are occupying a given territory with both the general population (Form 7-24) and this schedule for Indian population, make two independent series of numbers for these columns, one series in each kind of schedule, so that the last numbers on the two schedules when added together will correctly give the whole number of dwellings and of families visited and enumerated in your entire district.

Column 2.—If Indians are occupying a given territory with both the general population (Form 7-24) and this schedule for Indian population, supporting and partly depending upon the general population, enter the same number in both columns 1 and 2, and then the letter "B" (in parentheses). If the Indians are not supporting and mostly independent, write "Independent" in parentheses.

Column 3.—If Indians are occupying a given territory with both the general population (Form 7-24) and this schedule for Indian population, supporting and partly depending upon the general population, enter the same number in both columns 1 and 2, and then the letter "B" (in parentheses).

The following instructions apply to columns 29 to 34:

Column 29.—Write the Indian name, if the person has one, in addition to the English name given in column 3. If the Indian has only one name, Indian or English, repeat the name in this column.

Column 30.—If the Indian was born in this country, obtain the name of the tribe with which the person is connected. In any event secure the name of the tribe with which the person is connected and the name of the tribe of his or her parents, and enter the same in columns 30, 31, and 32.

Column 31.—If the Indian has no white blood, write "0". If he or she has white blood, write 1, 2, 3, which fraction is next to the number.

Column 32.—If the Indian is living with more than one wife, or if the Indian woman is a plural wife or has more than one husband, write "Yes". If not, write "No". If the Indian is single, leave the column blank.

Column 33.—If the Indian was born in this country, no entry can be made in columns 14, 17, or 18; but for columns 25, 26, and 27 answers must be obtained both in columns 14, 17, and 18, and in columns 25, 26, and 27, in accordance with the instructions given in this column.

Column 34.—If an Indian is to be considered "half-breed" if he or she is detached from his or her tribe and living among white people as an individual, and as such subject to taxation, whether he or she actually pays taxes or not; also if he or she is living with his or her tribe but has received an allotment of land, and thereby has acquired citizenship; in either of these two cases the answer to this inquiry is "Yes".

Column 35.—If the Indian was born in tribal relations, but has acquired American citizenship, write the year in which it was acquired. If he or she has not acquired citizenship, leave the column blank.

Column 36.—If the Indian acquired citizenship by receiving an allotment of land from the Government, write "Yes". If he or she received an allotment of land, but did not receive citizenship, write "No".

Column 37.—If the Indian is living in a tent, house, or other temporary structure, write "movable". If he or she is living in a permanent dwelling of any kind, write "fixed".

The following instructions apply to columns 28 to 30:  
COLUMN 28.—Write the Indian name, if the person has one, in addition to the English name given in column 3. If the Indian has only one name, write it in this column.

COLUMNS 20, 21, AND 22.—If the Indian was born in this country answers should be obtained, if possible, to inquiries 12, 14, and 15, relating to the birth of the name and of his or her parents. In any event

**COLON 20.**—If the Indian is living in a tent, tepee, or other temporary structure, write "movable." If he or she is living in a permanent dwelling of any kind, write "fixed."

This numbered form of Schedule No. 1 is to be used in making up the enumeration of Indians, both those on reservations and those living in family groups outside of reservations.

Detached Indians living either in white or negro families outside of reservations should be enumerated on the general population schedule (Form 7-224) as members of the families in which they are found; but detached whites or negroes living in Indian families should be counted on this schedule as members of the Indian families in which they are found. In other words, every family composed mainly of Indians should be reported entirely on this schedule, and every family composed mainly of persons not Indian should be reported entirely on the general population schedule.

This schedule contains on each side twenty horizontal lines, each running twice across the page, and it is consequently possible to accommodate on the A side only forty persons (twenty persons on the A side and twenty persons on the B side). Each Indian should be carried through from the beginning to the end of the line on which he is entered, as Line 1, Line 2, etc., and each individual from column 1 to column 26 which applies to the individual case should be numbered.

**COLUMNS 1 TO 20.**—These columns are identical with those on the general population schedule. For each column, so far as the inquiry applies, instructions are given in accordance with the instructions for filling the corresponding columns in the general population schedule, but note the following additional instructions in relation to filling columns 1, 8, and 10:
