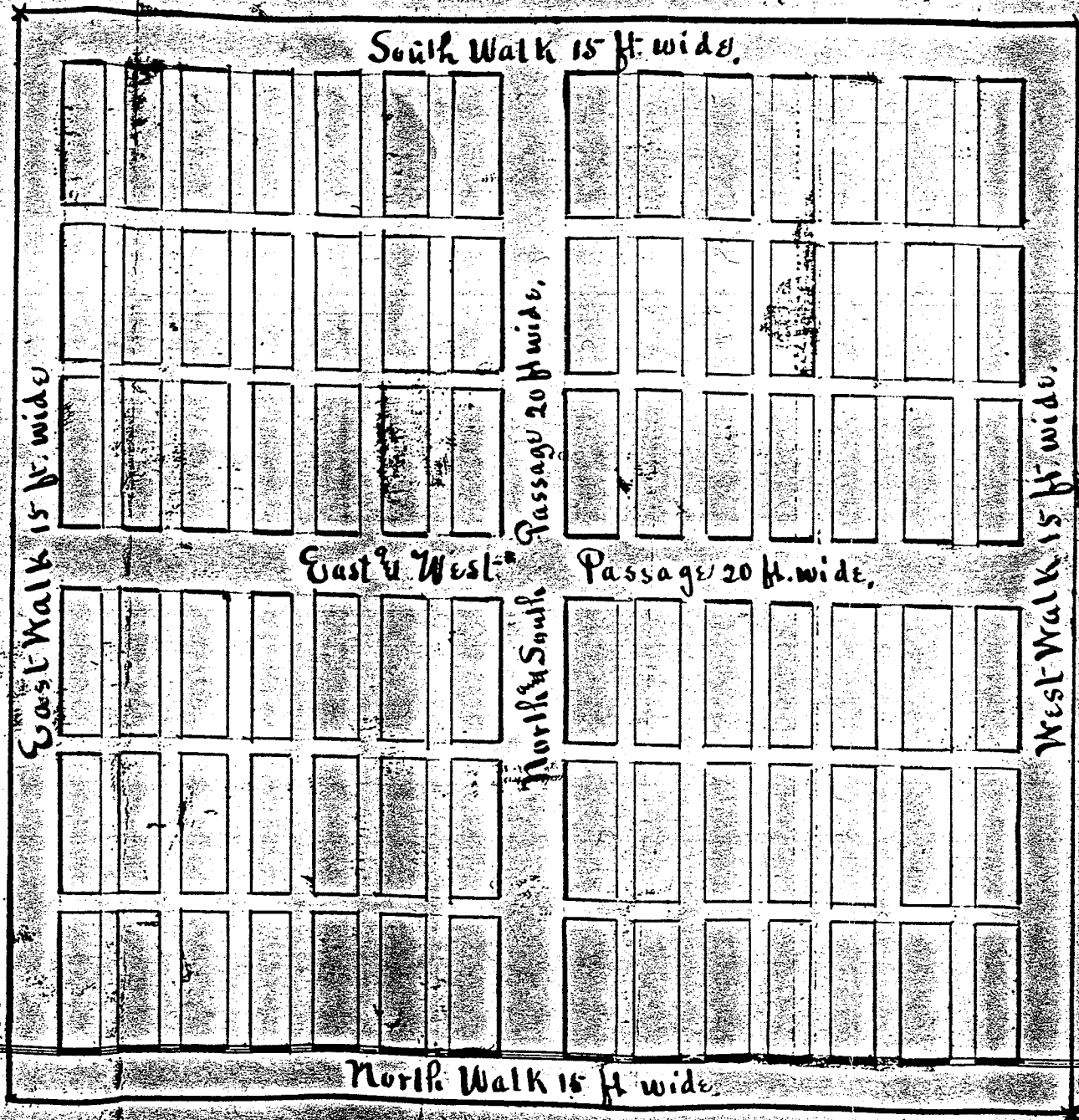


Plat of Fairview Cemetery.



Fairview Cemetery was surveyed by commencing at a stone planted in the present public highway and situated near the corner of the S.E. Cor. of S.W. 1/4 Sec 34 T. 31 N. R. 3 E. 13711, thence N 5 ch, thence W 5 ch, thence S 5 ch, thence E 5 ch, to place of beginning. A walk way 15 ft wide was there surveyed parallel and adjoining its exterior boundary, and the remaining area divided by two passages 20 ft in width running North & South

Entailed 15 inches in earth in the present public highway and standing at the ultimate point of the right angle formed by present South East boundary fir board plank fence standing on said 1/4 section — Thence North five (5) chains along line of said East boundary fence to a red fir peg shown in the earth thence west in a right angle five (5) chains to a stone with approximate dimensions of 10x12x15 inches and chisel marked by a cross near the upper end and facing S.E. 9 m - braded 14 inches in earth, thence South at right angle five (5) chains to a red fir post shown in the line of the aforementioned North boundary fence, thence east at right angle five (5) chains along line of said fence to place of beginning and containing two and one half (2 1/2) acres, to-wit: together with that tract of land belonging to said S.W. 1/4 of Sec 34, T 31 N R 3 E B 9 M and

And provided further that any lot or which a grave has been dug at the time of the public sale of lots aforesaid shall not be subject to sale but shall be sold to the person who solicited it, at a price proportional

to that of other lots sold on the same date situated at the time of such public sale. And provided further that a majority of the trustees may at all times purchase or sell under the trust and by what

and East and West, into four blocks of equal
area 120 ft square and designated upon
the Plat by: "A" "B" "C" and "D" Block A
being ~~sub~~ in the N. E. division and
lettering West and back, each. The

Block were then subdivided into
twenty one (21) lots each of dimensions
of 14 x 43 feet, being three feet ^{deep} North & South
and seven feet deep East & West, with
alley ways five and one half (5 1/2) feet wide
passing the ends of the lots and extend-
ing East & West; and alley ways seven
(7) feet wide passing the sides of the
lots and extending North & South. The
lots being numbered from 1 to 21 inclu-
sive commencing with one in the
N. E. cor of each Block numbering
West, second East and third West end-
ing with 21 in the S. W. corner of
the Block. The corners of each Block
and of each lot were located in the
survey by pine & fir pegs 2 inches in di-
ameter and 16 in. in length driven to the
surface of the ground, and are indi-
cated upon the plat by a cross mark
thus x The figures upon the lots in the
plat designate the number of the lot.
